Enrollment Update

Rockford Christian welcomed 103 new students for the 2023-2024 school year, and started the year with a total enrollment of 702 students in PreK-12 grade! Despite several years of decreasing population trends in the Rockford area, we are pleased that Rockford Christian retention rates remain strong (at 95% or higher) and enrollment has stabilized at approximately 50 students per grade level.


