Tips for a Successful School Year

While the days are long, the years are short, leaving parents and students undoubtedly wanting to make the most of this year's educational experience. To help set your child up for success, consider these tips for a great school year.

How can I support my student?

- Pray as the first response, rather than the last resort.
- Keep communicating, but be quick to listen and slow to speak.
- Model college or career readiness skills such as grit, social intelligence, self-control, gratitude, and hope.
- Establish home study routines and spaces.
- Allow them to experience natural consequences.
- Make them participate in at least one activity this year.
- Network with other school families. You'll realize your family is "normal."
- Nurture hearts to maintain the right perspective.
- Ask for help when you see something concerning.

In the spring of 2023, Rockford Christian used a (new to us) summative assessment, called CTP5, with grades 1-10 to assist in evaluating and benchmarking our curriculum and pacing guides. This new assessment replaced the discontinued ACT Aspire and was intentionally selected because it provides a set of comparison data to national independent schools, a comparison not typically provided when using state assessments or those common to public school systems. 

Congratulations to Rockford Christian senior Connor Magnuson, who has been named a semi-finalist in the 2024 National Merit Scholarship Program!

Of the over 1.3 million students across the country who take the PSAT/NMSQT exam, just 16,000 semi-finalists continue in the competition for National Merit Scholarships worth nearly \$28 million. The nationwide pool of semi-finalists represents less than one percent of U.S. high school seniors. Merit Scholars are selected on the basis of their skills, accomplishments, and potential for success in rigorous college studies.



Congratulations to RC senior Sara Koshi, who was recognized as a Commended Student in the 2024 National Merit Scholarship Program! As a Commended Student, Sara was in the top 3% of high scorers on the qualifying PSAT/NMSQ exam.

While over 1.3 million students take the exam, only about 34,000 high scorers are designated as Commended Students. In recognition of their outstanding ability and potential for academic success in college, NMSC honors these talented students with Letters of Commendation.
